ORDER

1. Affidavit dated 21.08.2025 has been filed by Mr. Bhuvan Prakash
Yadav, Regional Officer, UPPCB, Meerut. In the affidavit, reference has

been made to list of all CBWTFs in the State of U.P. (Annexure-1), Gap Analysis report (Annexure-2) and CPCB Guidelines dated 12.04.2025 (Annexure-3).

2. Affidavit merely contains the references to the above-mentioned documents without mentioning action taken for implementation of CPCB Guidelines on the basis of Gap Analysis Report. The affidavit does not, in fact, give any material information to this Tribunal and is, therefore, liable to be discarded.

3. We have gone through the Gap Analysis Report but even with reference to the CBWTF in question in the present case, we do not find answer to the relevant questions regarding HCFs covered by it at the time of its inception and at present, area of its operation and also compliance and non-compliance as observed by UPPCB.

4. Learned counsel for UPPCB seeks time to file fresh affidavit giving requisite details.

5. Learned counsel for CPCB also seeks time to file affidavit with respect to the changes carried out by CPCB Guidelines dated 12.04.2025 and also status of compliance of the same.

6. Respondent no. 8 is directed to file its affidavit regarding (i) number of HCFs and veterinary facilities operating in each of the Districts covered by it, (ii) number of HCFs and veterinary facilities with which agreement has been entered into by respondent no. 8, (iii) number of HCFs and veterinary facilities which are not covered by respondent no. 8 in said Districts, (iv) quantity of bio-medical waste generated in said Districts, (v) capacity of respondent no. 8 for treatment and disposal of bio-medical waste and (vi) quantity of bio medical waste treated/disposed of by respondent no. 8.

7. Affidavits as directed above may be filed by respondents no. 2, 4, 5 and 8 at least three days before the next date of hearing fixed.

8. List on 14.10.2025 for further orders/proceedings.
