ORDER

1. In this Original Application (OA), Tribunal is examining the grievance against discharge of untreated sewage from the drains of Nagar Palika Parishad, Baraut in the Irrigation Canal known as Rajwahe.
2. Nagar Palika Parishad, Baraut has filed the action plan in compliance of the earlier order of the Tribunal on 06.11.2025 disclosing the setting up of 04 Decentralised Sewage Treatment Plants (DSTPs) to remediate the problem of discharge of sewage in the canal. The timeline for completing these DSTPs as disclosed in the latest report is as under:-

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3. Learned Counsel appearing for UPPCB has submitted that so far as the first DSTP of 50 KLD capacity is concerned, it is functional and is complying with the norms. In respect of the other DSTPs, timeline is yet to come. Hence, prayer for adjournment has been made to inform the status of setting up and performance of those DSTPs. Prayer is allowed.

4. The Nagar Palika Parishad, Baraut is also required to disclose if Kotana Road Drain and Baraut West Sector (Drain 3) are the storm water drains and if so, how sewage is allowed to discharge in the storm water drains in violation of environmental norms.
