ORDER

1. In this original application, residents of village Dostpur Mangrauli and other adjacent villages of Noida, District Gautam Budh Nagar have raised the grievance that respondent authorities had failed to take preventive measures for controlling the entry of flood water of River Yamuna in their properties during the flood between 12th -15th July, 2023, as a result of which they had suffered the loss. Further grievance is that even after the flood had receded, no action for removing the sludge and dry silt was taken, which resulted in health hazards and damage to the properties.
2. A report at the instance of District Magistrate, Gautam Budh Nagar has been filed.

3. Learned Counsel appearing for State of UP is directed to supply a copy of the report to the applicant within three days. It will be opened to the applicant to file objections to the report, if any, within four weeks.

4. Learned Counsels for the respondents also seek four weeks' time to file their response. Permission is granted.
