ORDER

1. A letter has been circulated by Counsel for State of Uttar Pradesh seeking adjournment for filing the fresh action taken report on behalf of Chief Secretary, State of Uttar Pradesh.
2. Learned Counsel submits that reports have been called from different authorities and review meeting under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary is fixed for 13.07.2025 and action taken report will be filed within three weeks. Prayer is allowed.
3. Tribunal in the proceedings dated 21.05.2025 had recorded the submission of Counsel for respondent no.7 that show cause notices were

issued to remove the encroachment upon the park/road. No reply to the show cause notice was received till that date and that respondent no.7 would wait for another 45 days for receipt of the reply and thereafter will take action.

4. Learned Counsel appearing for respondent no.12 has informed that reply dated 02.06.2025 to the show cause notice was filed on 03.06.2025 before respondent no.7 which also contained the request for giving personal hearing.

5. Learned Counsel for respondent no.7 submits that there is no objection in giving a personal hearing to respondent no.12 and same will be given within four weeks and date of personal hearing will be informed through Counsel for respondent no.12.

6. Learned Counsel for respondent no. 7 submits that similar opportunity of personal hearing will also be given to respondent nos. 13 to 34 and in the same manner the intimation fixing date of hearing will be given through the Counsel for respondent nos. 13 to 34.

7. Respondent no.7 is directed to disclose the outcome of personal hearing on or before the next date of hearing.
