**ORDER**

1. Prayers in this application are as follows:-

- “a. take on record the present application on record and allow the same directing the Respondents to;*
- b. de-seal the Applicant Unit and restore the electricity thereof;*
- c. waive off/cancel the exorbitant compensation erroneously imposed against the Applicant Unit;*
- d. grant consent, if necessary under the law, as already applied by the Applicant;*
- e. pass such other further Order(s), direction(s) as this Hon'ble Tribunal may deem fit and proper under the facts and circumstances of the present case.”*

2. In substance the applicant is challenging sealing of the unit and levy of the compensation by the State PCB. Remedy to challenge the said order is by way of statutory appeal which has not been filed. No reason has been given for avoiding the said remedy.

3. The application is thus, not maintainable and is accordingly dismissed.
