ORDER

1. Tribunal by order dated 04.03.2025 had granted 10 days' time to State of UP to file response to each of the points and recommendations mentioned in the submission of the applicant and also to give timeline along with name of responsible officer for adhering to the said timeline for remediating the problem. Though, State of UP has filed the affidavit dated 04.04.2025 but neither the timeline nor officers responsible/accountable to complete the work within the timeline has been disclosed in clear terms.

2. Learned AAG, State of UP submits that within two weeks positively timeline and accountable person not only in respect of these 1st 10 districts but for the next 10 districts will also be disclosed by way of

affidavit of Secretary, Environment, State of UP. We make it clear that in that affidavit name and designation of one officer in each district accountable for completing the work within the timeline will be disclosed.
