ORDER

1. The issue raised in this application is violation of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 and violation of the guidelines issued by NGT by the Municipal Corporation, Hisar. The household waste is collected without segregation which is causing huge loss to exchequer and also causing environmental loss. The wet and dry waste is not only being collected as mixed waste but domestic hazardous waste is also being collected as mixed waste. The garbage disposal vehicles do not reach all households as a result of which the citizens are forced to dump the garbage in open, which leads to public health hazards.

2. We have also noted the data furnished by the State of Haryana through its Additional Chief Secretary on 3.6.2021 in OA No. 1011/2018, Jagdish Kumar vs. State of Haryana that there was 1.3 lakh MT of legacy

waste in Hisar and some steps have been taken to remediate the site. The directions were issued to remediate such legacy waste which is created on account of gap existing between waste generation and processing.

3. Before proceeding further, we deem it just and proper to call a report in the matter in issue in present Original Application, from a Joint Committee consisting of:

- (i) Collector, Hisar
- (ii) One representative from Haryana State PCB

4. The Committee is directed to visit the place and submit the factual and action taken report within four weeks. The State PCB will be the nodal agency for coordination and logistic support. The report may include status of solid waste management for Hisar which inter-alia to include quantification in terms of waste generation, waste processed and remedial measures taken to bridge gap between waste generation and processing and legacy waste remediated

5. Applicant is directed to supply the copy of the application and relevant documents to the Committee and Respondent(s) within a week and after compliance of service, the applicant has to submit an affidavit that the notice and copy of the application have been served upon the Committee and respondent(s).

6. The report in the matter be filed by the Committee through E-filing portal at judicial-ngt@gov.in preferably in the form of searchable PDF/OCR Support PDF and not in the form of Image PDF

List for further consideration on 06.09.2023.
