ORDER

1. On previous occasion i.e. on 17.10.2022 the case was listed for admission but Mr. Omkar Devdas, learned Counsel for the Appellants had sought adjournment on grounds of his personal difficulty. Thereafter, the case was again listed on 04.11.2022 for admission and on this date also adjournment had been sought by the learned Counsel for the Appellants on the ground that he has been hospitalized and thereafter the case was again listed on 10.11.2022 for admission and on this date also the case was adjourned due to non-availability of the Counsel for the Appellants.
2. Today Mr. Omkar Devdas, learned Counsel appearing (in Virtual Mode) has put in appearance on behalf of the Appellants.
3. **I.A. No. 245/2022/EZ** has been filed by the Appellants, seeking condonation of delay in filing the present Memo of Appeal.
4. We find that in the I.A. sufficient cause for condonation of delay has not been explained, although it is stated that the Appellant No.1 was detected with early case of cancer but it has not been

explained as to from what date to what date he was under treatment and, therefore, disabled from filing the present Appeal.

5. The I.A. No. 245/2022/EZ is rejected.
6. The learned Counsel for the Appellants prays for and is granted four weeks time for filing a better I.A. showing sufficient cause for condoning the delay in filing the present Appeal.
