ORDER

1. Learned Counsel for the applicant Ms. Diksha Chaturvedi has submitted that in the joint committee report at point no. (B) there is report narrating (i) uncontrolled sand mining in river Chambal and excessive legally sanctioned and illicit fishing activities (ii) substantial threat critically endangered gharial and Gangetic river dolphins and further that (iii) the generation of the domestic waste water in the Kota city is to the extent of 312 MLD while capacity of treatment is only 50 MLD, through two numbers of sewage treatment plants (iv) The State PCB had issued notices under section 33 (A) Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 against the Nagar Nigam Kota to

stop the discharge of untreated sewage water into the Chambal river but no remedial measures have been taken by the authorities concerned. Kota Municipal Corporation is respondent in this case but no reply has been filed. Issue reminder to the respondent to file the reply within 15 days.

2. In the meantime, State PCB is directed to submit the report with regard to the non compliance of EC conditions by the industries situated at the bank of river and in case there is any discharge of untreated water towards the river without treating the water as per parameter necessary remedial measures must be taken. The status with action taken by the State PCB must be reported to this Tribunal before 22.10.2024.
