ORDER

1. In compliance with our previous order dated 03.10.2023, the Maharashtra Maritime Board has been impleaded as respondent No.4 by the Registry and notice was issued to it in pursuance of which learned counsel Mr. Saket Mone has appeared and states that the Maharashtra Maritime Board is not the owner of the land in question. We direct him to file an affidavit to that effect.
2. From the side of the applicant, today an adjournment is sought by the learned counsel for the applicant through an email dated 01.04.2024 sent by him, on the ground that he is in travel. The request for adjournment is allowed.
3. From the side of respondent No.2 – MCZMA, learned counsel Ms. Pooja Natu holding brief of learned counsel Ms. Manasi Joshi has appeared and apprised us that in compliance of earlier order, copy of the

Joint Committee report has been served upon the applicant on 05.10.2023, but so far, no objection against the same has been filed by the applicant.

4. From the side of respondent No.3 – District Collector, the direction as per previous order has been complied with by filing English translation of the documents in question.

5. From the side of respondent No.2 – MCZMA, reply-affidavit dated 30.01.2024 has been filed, which is annexed at pages 21 to 40 of the paper-book, wherein it has been made clear that they had sought names of the concerned persons, who had made concrete structure on the seashore, by writing letters to the Maharashtra Maritime Board as well as to the District Collector. The Maharashtra Maritime Board has provided the names of those persons being (1) Shri Vithoba Shantaram Koli, at post Thal-Chalmala, (2) Shri Naresh Navnath Koli, at post Thal-Chalmala, (3) Shri Kishore Balaram Koli, at post Thal-Chalmala and (4) Shri Mangesh Shravan Bodke, at post Thal-Chalmala. It is further mentioned in this affidavit that the District Coastal Zone Management Committee (DCZMA) has been requested to take follow-up action in the matter but what happened thereafter has not been made clear in this affidavit. Four weeks' time is granted to respondent No.2 – MCZMA to obtain report from DCZMA as to what action has been taken from their side and submit the same before us before the next date.

6. Put up this matter for next consideration on 19.07.2024.
