ORDER

1. From the side of the appellant, learned counsel Mr. Nitin Lonkar has appeared and drawn our attention to the application dated 04.07.2023, which has not been numbered by the Registry finding it to be defective because this I.A. was not filed in "IA Section", nor necessary fee prescribed was paid by the appellant/applicant.

2. The learned counsel for the appellant was directed by us vide order dated 29.05.2023, to provide the documents in order to show that the appellant herein was a registered Trust and Shri Bhagwanbhai s/o Bhanabhai Solanki was its President. In compliance of that order, the learned counsel for the appellant has drawn our attention to Annexure-A1, annexed to the said defective I.A., which is a Certificate of Registration and the name of Public Charitable Trust is "Paryavaran Suraksha Avam Jankalyan Samiti" and the certificate was issued to its President Shri Solanki Bhagwanbhai Bhanabhai.

3. We find that the present appeal has been filed by the appellant by name "Protection of Environment and Public Service Committee". We direct the learned counsel for the appellant to move necessary amendment application alongwith the amendment to be carried in respect of the name of the appellant i.e. "Paryavaran Suraksha Avam Jankalyan Samiti" through its President Shri Bhagwanbhai Bhanabhai Solanki and also the I.A. shall be filed in appropriate Section after payment of the prescribed fee. The learned counsel for the appellant is also directed to provide the proof that the said Trust is operational in the State of Maharashtra as well.

4. For the compliance of the above directions, the learned counsel for the appellant seeks two weeks' time. The same is allowed.

5. Put up this matter for admission on 21.07.2023.
