ORDER

1. In compliance with our previous order dated 04.02.2025 in paragraph No.3, respondent No.2 has filed I.A. No.64 of 2025 (WZ), wherein in paragraph No.2, following is stated:

“That in the array of parties the names of Respondent No.4 is Khurshid Chaudhary and the name of Respondent No.17 is Bablu Soni. The above names be deleted and substituted with the correct and proper names of the aforesaid Respondents being Respondent No.4 – Khurshid Alam Masiuddin Khan, Respondent No.17 – Shravan Kumar Rangilal Soni.”

2. Having heard the learned counsel for respondent No.2, we allow this I.A. as prayed and since the applicant has stopped attending the proceeding in the present matter, we direct the Registry to incorporate the correct names of respondent Nos.4 and 17 as mentioned in the I.A. 64/2025 in the array of parties of O.A., within two days.

3. It is further stated by the learned counsel for respondent No.2 that the addresses of respondent Nos.4 and 17 are the same as are given earlier in the memo of Original Application. In view thereof, we direct the Registry to

issue notice to respondent Nos.4 and 17, returnable within four weeks, to be served by respondent No.2 dasti as well as by registered post.

4. Learned counsel for respondent Nos.3 to 22, except respondent Nos.4 and 17, has appeared and states that he was to be provided English translation of the Marathi documents, which are at pages 8 to 15 of the paper-book, which are filed by the applicant, who has stopped attending the proceeding of this case. In view of the applicant having stopped attending the proceeding, we direct that these documents in Marathi language (page Nos.8 to 15 of the paper-book) shall be served by the Registry upon learned counsel for respondent No.2 – PCMC, who shall get those documents translated into English and copy of the translated documents of those pages shall be served upon learned counsel for respondent Nos.3 to 22 (except respondent Nos.4 and 17), within four weeks.

5. Put up this matter on 28.04.2025.
