ORDER

1. From the side of the applicant, the applicant-in-person is present and submits that the service-affidavit has been filed, as per which all the respondents have been served.

6. From the side of respondent No.9 – M/s Nyati Builder Pvt. Ltd., learned counsel Mr. Saket Mone has appeared and states that because of some technical problem, reply-affidavit could not be e-filed by him, but the same has been served through e-mail upon the other parties. The applicant states that the said e-mail is not accessible as the file is not opening. Therefore, we direct learned counsel for respondent No.9 to e-file the same within two weeks, with a direction that a copy of the same shall be served on all the parties.
