ORDER

1. This appeal is challenging the grant of Environmental Clearance dated 24.08.2020 in favour of the 2nd respondent.
2. The Learned Counsel appearing for the appellant would state that earlier there was O.A. No. 180 of 2017 challenging the Environmental Clearance dated 28.03.2016 given in favour of the Karnataka Industrial Area Development Board, who was the project proponent. In addition to that

there was also an Appeal no. 20 of 2019 challenging the grant of Environmental Clearance which was heard together by this Tribunal and an order was passed on 27.07.2022 by the Special Bench which was dismissed against the appellant.

3. It is now stated that two Review Applications, namely, R.A. Nos. 10 and 11 of 2022, are filed and they are yet to be listed. The contention of the appellant was that whether the area in which the Karnataka Industrial Area Development Board has proposed to establish the industry is coming within the purview of eco-sensitive zone. According to the appellant, if the same issue is decided in the review applications, it will have bearing on this appeal also.
4. Nevertheless, the appellant has raised various other grounds also while challenging the Environmental Clearance. However, just to wait for the outcome of the R.A. Nos. 10 and 11 of 2022, the matter is listed again for hearing on 08.12.2022.
5. Post the matter for hearing on 08.12.2022.
