ORDER

1. The learned counsel for the Respondent No. 6 – M/s. United Infrastructures has submitted that the order dated 18.02.2026 passed by this Tribunal directing the Respondent No. 6 to take necessary steps to have the relinquishment deed executed and set things right, could not be complied with, because of the pendency of this case the transfer of e-khata is not possible to be done. Therefore, he says that the only solution to this problem is that this application is disposed of with the direction to the Respondent No. 6 to get the e-khata be transferred in favour of the Government.

2. What we find is that at this stage, the learned counsel for the applicant has appeared after a long time and stated that he has obtained the No Objection from the earlier counsel after a delay. He may be permitted to go through the entire record and then only he can submit before this Tribunal. We allow him a week's time for the same.

3. We direct the Registry to place the matter on 13.07.2026 for final hearing.
