ORDER

1. Earlier, this Tribunal had passed an order dated 28.09.2022 as follows:-

“19. In the said affidavit of undertaking the project proponent has stated that he has furnished the sketch showing the proposed construction to be taken up as a drainage canal and the construction work was commenced on 22.08.2022 in the manner and conditions prescribed by the Water Resource Department in its letter dated 18.08.2022. The said undertaking is recorded. However, for the completion of the same, the 7th respondent has requested four months time to complete the construction of the storm water drain. He had also furnished photographs to show that the work had commenced and that he would complete try to complete the same before the onset of the monsoon.”

2. Now, the above miscellaneous application is filed seeking an extension of time as though the brickwork has been completed, final plastering and concrete work is yet to be done. The delay was caused due to the monsoon and cyclone Mandous. As the applicant has sought for only three more months time, the same is granted. The applicant is directed to complete the work within the time granted now without asking for further extension.
3. Accordingly, this miscellaneous application [M.A. No.14 of 2022 (SZ)] is closed.
