ORDER

1. This is an interlocutory application [**I.A. No. 142 of 2025 (SZ)**] filed by Applicant No.1, Jakkamsetti Baburao, seeking immediate payment of Rs.20,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Lakhs only) towards the applicant's kidney

transplant and related medical treatment, considering his urgent and life-threatening condition.

2. It is alleged that, due to prolonged exposure to continuous air pollution from brick kilns, the applicant has suffered permanent and irreversible damage to both kidneys. He has been undergoing medical treatment, incurring huge expenditure. At present, he requires approximately Rs.21,00,000/- for a kidney transplant, which has been medically advised.

3. Though, in the main application, there is a prayer seeking compensation for extensive medical expenses, vision loss and suffering and a claim of Rs.20,00,000/- has been made, there cannot be any interim payment as sought for in I.A. No.142 of 2025 (SZ).

4. While we express our deep concern for the health of the applicant, such applications before this Tribunal, particularly seeking interim relief, cannot be entertained before the entitlement to compensation and its quantum are determined.

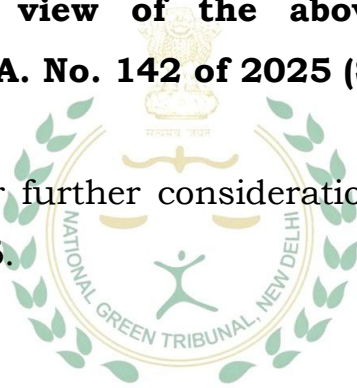
5. If the compensation payable has already been quantified by any authority or by this Tribunal and the authorities are refusing to disburse the same, appropriate directions may be issued. However, before even deciding the applicant's entitlement and the quantum payable, this interlocutory application is premature.

6. Though we do not wish to state anything further, we record the submission made by the learned Standing Counsel appearing for the State of Andhra Pradesh. He has stated that State Medical Insurance is available to citizens and that the State Government is also extending assistance to those who are in penury and seeking medical aid.

7. Therefore, it is open to the applicant to approach the appropriate department of the Government for the aid, he is seeking for urgently.

8. In view of the above, the interlocutory application [I.A. No. 142 of 2025 (SZ)] is closed.
