ORDER

1. In O.A. No.56 of 2023 (SZ), the counter of the 3rd Respondent dated 23.05.2023 is filed.
2. In O.A. No.56 of 2023 (SZ), this Tribunal passed the following interim order on 04.05.2023:

“9. Therefore, we have no hesitation to pass an order directing the respondent authorities to stop any kind of work, including the patchwork falling within the scope of the project forthwith. Despite this order, if there is any violation found, it will be viewed seriously by this Tribunal.”

3. An interlocutory application [I.A. No.58 of 2023 (SZ) in O.A. No.56 of 2023 (SZ)] is filed by the applicant stating that in disobedience of the order of this Tribunal, the project proponent is proceeding with the work. He also stated that the order passed by this Tribunal was communicated to the learned counsels on 08.05.2023.

4. The applicant also produced photographs with latitude and longitude details which were taken on 20.05.2023 i.e. after the interim order against the project proponent was passed.
5. However, Mr. A. Sanjeev Kumar, the learned Special Government Pleader who is personally present today, upon oral instructions, stated that there is no activity going on, which is disputed by the learned counsel for the applicant that even as on date when the matter is being heard, the project proponent is proceeding with the work.
6. The learned Special Government Pleader seeks time to file his counter to the Interlocutory Application.
7. **Once again we reiterate that the interim order of this Tribunal should be followed in its letter and spirit. Eventually, if it is found that the project proponent is proceeding with the work, the same would be viewed very seriously.**
8. Post the matter on 17.07.2023.
