ORDER

I.A. No.139 of 2022 in Appeal No.42 of 2022:

1. There is a delay of 59 days in filing the above appeal. Having satisfied with the reasons stated in the application and also as there is no serious objection from the respondents, the delay is condoned.

Appeal Nos.42 & 38 of 2022:

2. The appeal is challenging the Environmental Clearance dated 29.04.2022.

3. The primordial allegation of the appellant is that the project being established is highly polluting Red and Orange category industries like Automobile, Electrical Equipment, Metals, Machinery and also Food and Agro processing. The area falls in 17 revenue villages in Nyalkal Mandal and Jharasangam Mandal of Sangareddy District, State of Telangana.
4. According to the appellant, around 83% of the land in project site is crop agricultural area and there are about 27 varieties of crops being grown. As fertile cultivable land is used for that project, the same should not have been granted the Environmental Clearance.
5. It is also alleged that the questions raised by the public have not been answered satisfactorily by the authorities. As it is stated that the appraisal itself is faulty, challenge is being made.
6. Mr. S. Rajasekar, the learned counsel accepts notice for the MoEF&CC, Mrs. H. Yasmeen Ali, the learned counsel accepts notice for State of Telangana, Mr. T. Sai Krishnan, the learned counsel accepts notice for Telangana State Pollution Control Board and Mr. A. Sanjeev Kumar, the learned Special Government Pleader, State of Telangana accepts notice for the 4th respondent in Appeal No.42 of 2022 and respondents Nos.3 & 4 in Appeal No.38 of 2022.
7. The appellant is directed to serve the papers on the respondents to enable them to file their counter.
