In the matter of: Application under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 alleging non-compliance of order dated 25.05.2024 of the Learned GRF, Paradeep passed in C.C. Case No.32 of 2024.

This matter is taken up for hearing through hybrid arrangement.

2. Shri Rabin Kishore Behera, the Authorized Representative of the Petitioner-Sri Sadashiba Das and Shri Ashok Kumar Nayak, DM, JED, Jagatsinghpur, TPCODL, the Respondent-Licensee do appear. The reply filed by the Respondent and the Memo of compliance report submitted by the Petitioner is taken on record.
3. The Petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 seeking execution of the order dated 25.05.2024 of the Learned GRF, Paradeep passed in C.C. Case No.32 of 2024. The Learned GRF, Paradeep while disposing of C.C. Case No.32 of 2024, has issued the following directions:

“The O.P shall further determine remunerative norms basing on estimate amount of 250 kVA instead of 500 kVA and shall intimate to the complainant his share of charges liable for payment supplying a copy of the same to the complainant within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of the order. Thereafter, the entire process shall be completed within a month”.

4. The matter was remanded to the learned GRF, Paradeep by the Commission, vide order dated 05.11.2024 in Case No.71 of 2024, to verify whether their order has been implemented by the Respondent-licensee in letter and spirit. The learned GR, Paradeep vide their letter dated 03.07.2025, had communicated that revised estimate has been prepared by the Opposite Party and demand note has also been served to the Complainant on 23.06.2025 and the complainant has agreed to pay the demand made by the Opposite Party, accordingly grievance of the complainant stand resolved.
5. When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the Representative of the Respondent-Licensee, TPCODL drawing our attention to the affidavit of the Superintending Engineer of the Respondent-Licensee submits for closure of the case on the ground that the direction imparted in order dated 25.05.2024 of the Learned GRF, Paradeep has since been carried out.
6. The Authorized Representative of the Petitioner participated in the hearing online. To the query of the Commission, he also admits that the Respondent-Licensee has complied with the order of the Learned GRF, Paradeep (*supra*) and submits that the Petitioner is no longer interested to proceed with this case. A memo to that effect is also filed by the Petitioner.
7. In view of the implementation of the order dated 25.05.2024 of the Learned GRF, Paradeep passed in C.C. Case No.32 of 2024, the Commission finds nothing more to proceed in this case. Consequently, the case is disposed of on full satisfaction of the order of the Learned GRF, Paradeep.
