Present contempt petition has been filed alleging violation of interim order dated 30.09.2014 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in RSA-5120-2014 titled as “Ram Chander vs. Natho and others”, whereby while issuing notice of motion, the parties were directed to maintain status quo till further orders.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous as the main RSA-5120-2014 stands dismissed for non-prosecution vide order dated 27.3.2025.
