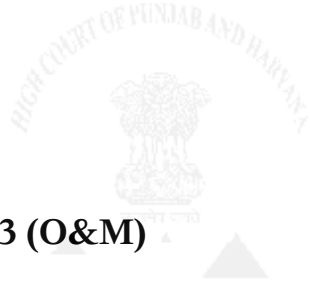

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, '*the Cr.P.C.*') for grant of permission to the petitioner to travel abroad with a further prayer for issuance of directions for renewal of the passport of the petitioner.
2. Concededly, as on today, the petitioner is not having any valid passport issued by the competent authority in his favour.
3. In view of the above, no such mandate can be issued to the authorities to allow the petitioner to travel abroad.
