1. On perusal of report dated 10.11.2023 sent by the Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class Moga, it transpires that the complainant has not come present for recording his statement with regard to the compromise.

2. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 disputes the factum of compromise and on instructions, he submits that the compromise has not been complied with by the petitioners and as such there is no ground for quashing the FIR as the compromise is not in existence between the parties.

3. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh petition, if any, for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.
