1 On 04.08.2023 the following order was passed:-

“Challenge is to the order dated 25.07.2023 passed by JMJC, Batala (Annexure P-4), whereby the bail order passed in favour of the petitioner has been cancelled and bail bonds/surety were forfeited in FIR No.17 dated 06.02.2018, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420 and 120-B of IPC, 1860 at Police Station Fatehgarh Churian, Batala, Gurdaspur.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was regularly appearing before the trial Court, but failed to appear only on 25.07.2023 due to heavy rain in the region and water logging.

Notice of motion for 28.09.2023.

Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Petitioner is granted liberty to surrender before the trial Court on or before 21.08.2023. In case the petitioner appears, he shall be released on interim bail.”

2 Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced the order dated 21.08.2023 to demonstrate that the petitioner indeed appeared before the trial Court on the said date in compliance of the order dated 04.08.2023 and was released on bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount. He further submits that the petitioner undertakes to appear regularly before the trial Court.

3 In view of above, the interim order dated 04.08.2023 passed by this Court is made absolute. However, he shall keep on appearing before the trial Court as and when required.

4 Petition stands disposed off.
