The petitioner(s) has/have been arrested in FIR No.383/2020 of Police Station Pratap Nagar, District Bhilwara for the offence(s) punishable under Section(s) 381, 408 and 384 of IPC. He/She/They has/have preferred this/these bail application(s) under Section 439 Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) has submitted that the charge-sheet has been filed and offence(s) alleged to have been committed by the petitioner(s) is/are triable by Magistrate.
