Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present FIR is nothing but a device to blackmail the petitioner as the grounds on which the departmental proceedings were initiated and the contents of the FIR are verbatim the same to the order passed by the District Supply Officer dated 09.04.2021. He submits that the proceedings initiated by the department for suspension of the license of the petitioner as well as the cancellation of the license have been stayed by this Court in the writ petitions filed by the petitioner. The writ petitions are pending before this Court.

Issue notice.

Since the State is represented by learned Public Prosecutor, therefore, notice be issued to respondent no.2 only, returnable on 03.01.2022.



Learned Public Prosecutor is directed to call for the case diary as well as the factual report on the next date of hearing.

Meanwhile and till the next date of hearing, the petitioner shall not be arrested in connection with FIR No.145/2021 registered at Police Station Jasrasar, District Bikaner.

However, the petitioner shall join the investigation and appear before the Investigating Officer as and when called upon to do so.
