It is submitted by learned counsel for the parties that the
issue raised in the present writ petition is squarely covered by
order passed in Choudhary Girdhari Ram Dhaka Siksha Samiti v.
State of Rajasthan & Ors. : S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.9660/2018,
decided on 09.05.2018 (at Jaipur Bench), wherein while following
the judgment in the case of S.D. Memorial Public Shikshan Samiti
v. State of Rajasthan & Ors. : S.B. Civil Writ Petition
No.1991/2018, certain directions have been issued by the said
Court.



In the case of Choudhary Girdhari Ram Dhaka Siksha Samiti

(supra), it was directed by the Co-ordinate Bench as under :-

"In that view of the matter, the writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner-Samiti to make a representation to the Principal Secretary, Agriculture, Government of Rajasthan ventilating its grievance/s and agitating its rights. The Principal Secretary, Agriculture in-turn is directed to dispose of the said representation by a reasoned, non discriminatory order reckoning for the observations / directions of this Court in the case of Ram Swaroop Agarwal Education and Research Society (supra) as upheld by the Division Bench of this Court, if the said judgment of this court has otherwise not stayed or set-aside by the Apex Court. The exercise be completed within four weeks of the receipt of the petitioner-society's representation."

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, the present writ petition is also disposed of in light of and with similar directions, issued in the case of Choudhary Girdhari Ram Dhaka Siksha Samiti (supra).

Stay petition is also decided.
