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**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE VIJAY BISHNOI**

**Order**

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the Condition No.4.6 in the Notification dated 01.02.2019 published on 24.05.2019 requiring enhanced sale and penalty on failure has no legal basis and the same is contrary to a part of the Liquor Policy itself, inasmuch as, the petitioner has been restrained from advertisement and/or attracting people for sale of liquor.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, issue notice. Issue notice of the stay application also, returnable within a period of four weeks and be given 'dasti' to learned counsel for the petitioner for service.



In the meanwhile and until further orders, the respondents would not take any coercive measure for recovery against the petitioner pursuant to the demand/list (Annexure-2) qua the petitioner.
