Shri Tomu Francis, learned advocate for the respondent submitted that there are few compliances remaining, out of which the major one is mismatch of 97,177 shares of the Company. The share certificates were in physical form and not in demat form. Pursuant to the order passed by the Hon'ble Gujarat High Court, appellant-Company has communicated to the shareholders to submit their share certificates in the physical form but the aforesaid number of share certificates have not been made available by the shareholders. Therefore, the appellant-Company is unable to comply with the same. He seeks a week's time to complete instructions.
