ORDER:

There is a delay of 59 days in the filing this appeal. For the reasons stated in the application, the delay in filing this appeal is condoned. The Misc. Application No. 208 of 2025 is disposed of.

2. Admit.

3. Exemption Application No. 231 of 2025 is allowed.

4. The appellant has been delisted by the BSE Ltd. Ms. Zarnaab Aswad, learned advocate for the respondent submitted that if the appellant complies with the deficiencies, respondent may consider its request for listing.

5. Learned advocate for the BSE also submitted that there is mismatch in 'issued' and 'traded' capital and RTA¹ Certificate has not been received. Further the details of the dispatch of the physical shares have also not been made available.

6. Learned advocate for the appellant submits that RTA Certificate and other details have been sent on October 12, 2024. He undertakes to produce the proof of dispatch as also furnish another set of copies. He seeks a week's time to complete all formalities.

7. Respondent shall send a list of non-compliances within a week to the appellant by email.

8. Call on June 10, 2025 to report compliances.
