ORDER:

Urgency application has worked for itself. Misc. Application No. 351 of 2025 stands disposed of.

2. For the reasons stated therein, the application for condonation of delay is allowed. Delay of 98 days is condoned. Misc Application No. 350 of 2025 disposed of.

3. The application for exemption is allowed. Misc. Application No. 352 of 2025 is disposed of.

4. Learned Advocate for the appellant submitted that the respondent has not given the list of pending compliances. Learned Advocate for the BSE submitted that such list has been provided along with the delisting order. Learned Advocate for the appellant seeks last chance to comply with the pending compliances if the details are furnished to the

appellant. Learned Advocate for the respondent submitted that the list of pending compliance will be communicated to the appellant by an e-mail within seven days. Learned Advocate for the appellant seeks four weeks' time to comply with all such shortfalls from the date of receipt of e-mail.

5. The company has been already delisted, therefore, application for seeking stay does not survive for consideration and the stay application is disposed of.
