

As per the agreement arrived at by the parties, the multiplier to be used would be 11 (eleven) in place of 18 (eighteen) as used by the learned Tribunal.</p> <p>In view of the above, the amount of compensation that would be payable to the claimant would come to Rs.2,69,000/- (Rupees two lakhs sixty nine thousand) which would be inclusive of transportation charges, funeral expenses and loss of estate.</p> <p>Consequently, the amount awarded passed by the learned Tribunal shall stands modified to the extent indicated above. Needless to say, the interest component shall remain the same. As further agreed to by the learned counsel between the parties, the National Insurance Company Ltd., i.e., the petitioner herein, shall pay the above agreed amount to the claimant, i.e., the respondent No.1, within one month from the date of this order.</p> <p>With the above directions, this Revision Petition stands disposed of.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"> (Justice A.
