Mr. Ujjwal Kumar Sinha, learned counsel appearing for the appellant/petitioner submits that in view of the definition of 'victim' as enshrined in sub-section (wa) of Section 2 read with proviso to Section 372 and Section 378 (4) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the appellant, being the victim, is not liable to make an application seeking leave of the Court to prefer an appeal against the order of acquittal.

Having regard to the fact that the case is cognizable by a Division Bench, list it on 12.12.2016 for consideration and also to decide as to whether the appeal is admissible without there being an application seeking leave of the Court for admission of the appeal.
