Pursuant to the order dated 26.10.2016, Mr. Tarak Kumar Sarkar, Deputy Registrar of Customs, Excise & Service Tax Appellate Tribunal, Eastern Bench, Kolkata is present in the Court. He submits that there is no post of Registrar at the Customs, Excise & Service Tax Appellate Tribunal, Eastern Bench, Kolkata. The Deputy Registrar is the competent authority. Mr. Sarkar has filed an affidavit dated 19.11.2016 stating the reason for non-disposal of the pending appeal before the Tribunal within the specified time granted by this Court.
