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Pursuant to the limited notice issued on the last occasion, the State Government has filed a detailed counter-affidavit. It has been stated that a special train has been organized from North India on 22nd May, 2020 having its origin station as Chandigarh and stoppages at Ambala, New Delhi and Muradabad (Uttar Pradesh) to evacuate stranded Sikkimese from the region with a request to the Nodal Officers of Government of Rajasthan, Punjab, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Delhi to facilitate the evacuation of all stranded Sikkimese from these states. The special train is scheduled to leave Delhi at 9:00 p.m. tonight. The learned Additional Advocate General submits that to be able to procure a ticket in the special train, persons stranded in New Delhi was required to go for an examination

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at the designated place at Saket at 8:00 a.m. this morning. Mr. Yam Kumar Subba, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not aware and therefore, did not go to Saket for the examination.

Considering the scenario, Mr. Yam Kumar Subba may forthwith contact the learned Additional Advocate General who has agreed to provide immediately all necessary phone numbers that are required to explore the possibility of the petitioner reaching Saket, even now, for his examination and procurement of the ticket on the scheduled train subject to the result of the examination. Mr. Yam Kumar Subba agrees to do so and to communicate the same to the petitioner immediately.

With the hope that the petitioner would be able to board the train scheduled at 9:00 p.m. tonight, the matter is adjourned to 26.05.2020 for orders.
