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O R D E R

Mr. S.S. Walia, Registrar, I.K. Gujral Punjab Technical University (Respondent No.4), is present in person in terms of the direction of this Court dated 22.07.2019.

It is submitted jointly by learned Counsel for the Petitioners, Respondent No.4 and Respondent No.8 that a meeting is scheduled to be held today at 11 a.m. between the representatives of the Petitioners, Respondent No.4 and Respondent No.8, in the Office of the University Grants Commission ('UGC') under the Chairmanship of Secretary, UGC. That three weeks' time may be afforded to all parties to arrive at a conclusion.

Considered and ordered accordingly.

On enquiry by this Court, it is submitted by learned Senior Counsel for Respondent No.4 that the amount of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh) only, each directed to be paid to each of the Petitioner-Students by 31.08.2019, vide Orders of this Court dated 22.07.2019, has not been paid. No application seeking time has been filed nor have reasons been furnished for such non-payment.

In such a circumstance, it is evident that Respondent No.4 has wilfully flouted the Orders of this Court.

Accordingly, issue Show Cause Notice to the Respondent No.4 as to why contempt proceedings as deemed fit, should not be initiated against the said Respondent.

It is further ordered that the amount of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh) only, each ordered to be paid to each of the Petitioner-Students vide Order dated 22.07.2019, shall be complied within three weeks from today, failing which appropriate legal measures shall be initiated against the defaulter, apart from adding interest to the said sum at a rate considered judicious by this Court.
