ORDER

Respondent No.4 has filed an additional affidavit dated 10-10-2020 submitting therein *inter alia* that the Respondent No.4-University has realised the anomalies in the degrees awarded in Bachelor in Mobile Computing and Internet [BMCI] and M.Sc. in Airline Tourism and Hospitality Management [M.Sc(ATHM)] and has addressed a letter to the Respondent No.8 (University Grants Commission) dated 24-09-2020 requesting recognition for the revised nomenclature of the two degrees, in terms of the UGC Notification dated 15-07-2014.

It is submitted by Learned Senior Counsel for the Respondent No.8 that they have to obtain instructions in this regard as no

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information has been given with regard to the receipt of the letter by Respondent No.8.

For the remaining degrees, Learned Senior Counsel for the Respondent No.4-University submits that the mark-sheets shall be handed over to the Petitioners, if so directed, by the Hon'ble Court.

Considered.

Let mark-sheets be handed over to the Deputy Registrar (Judicial) of the Registry of the High Court. Learned Counsel for the Petitioners shall collect the same from the said Officer after duly verifying it with Counsel for the Respondent No.4 for errors/anomalies, if any.

In compliance to the Order of this Court dated 10-10-2020, an affidavit dated 15-10-2020 has been filed by the Petitioner, to clarify the contents of I.A. No.13 of 2020, submitting therein that 224 number of students had been admitted to the Respondent No.4 University and the degrees that ought to be granted to the Petitioners as detailed in the petition.

RespondentNo.4-University shall peruse the affidavit *supra* and take necessary steps in this context on or before the next date.
