O R D E R

On 29.07.2021, this Court recorded *inter alia* as follows;

- (i) That, Learned Senior Counsel for the Respondent No.4 had handed over to Learned Counsel for the Petitioners rectified Degrees of 11 (eleven) students whose names had been incorrectly recorded in the Degrees handed over to them previously.
- (ii) 16 (sixteen) other students have received their Degrees in M.Sc. in Airline Tourism and Hospitality Management [M. Sc. (ATHM)].
- (iii) 13 (thirteen) students who were earlier awarded Degrees in Bachelor of Hotel Management, Travel and Tourism (BHMTT), were to be awarded revised Degrees in B. Sc. in Airline Tourism and

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Hospitality Management [B. Sc. (ATHM)], for reasons recorded in the Order.

Today, it is submitted by Learned Senior Counsel for the Respondent No.4 that revised Degrees for the 13 (students) *supra*, are prepared and will be handed over to Learned Counsel for the Petitioners, who accordingly undertakes to receive the said Degrees.

It is submitted by Learned Counsel for the Petitioners today that so far as the Degrees of the aggrieved students are concerned, all concerned students have received their Degrees, in terms of what has been recorded in the preceding Orders of this Court, hence nothing further remains for adjudication so far as the obtainment of the Degrees of the Petitioners are concerned.

I.A. No.11 of 2020 is an application filed by Respondent No.4 seeking to place certain documents on record. Learned Senior Counsel for Respondent No.4 submits that he does not seek to press this Petition. I.A. accordingly stands disposed of, as not pressed.

I.A. No.13 of 2020 is an application filed by the Petitioners seeking directions of this Court to Respondent No.4 to furnish clarification and to take appropriate steps relating to revised Degrees. Counsel for the Petitioners does not seek to press this Petition. I.A. stands disposed of, as not pressed.

In view of the foregoing Orders in I.A. No.13 of 2020, I.A. No.14 of 2020, which is an application filed by the Petitioners for reconsideration and modification of Order dated 11.11.2020 also stands disposed of.

Learned Counsel for the Petitioners submits that I.A. No.10 of 2019 is required to be considered by this Court, whereby the Petitioners have sought compensation for the delay in granting Degrees to them. Written response has been filed by Learned Senior Counsel for the Respondent No.4. Other Respondents submit they have no written response to file.
