ORDER

In terms of the Order of this Court dated 28.07.2021, Learned Counsel for the Petitioners submits that Learned Senior Counsel for the Respondent No.4 has handed over to him rectified Degrees of 11 (eleven) students whose names had been incorrectly recorded earlier.

It is submitted today that 16 (sixteen) students have already received Degrees in M.Sc. in Airline Tourism and Hospitality Management [M. Sc. (ATHM)].

Learned Counsel for the Petitioners further submits that 13 (thirteen) students who had earlier been awarded Degrees in BHMTT (Bachelor of Hotel Management, Travel and Tourism) are to be awarded revised Degrees in B.Sc. in Airline Tourism and

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Hospitality Management [B. Sc. (ATHM)], in view of the fact that the Respondent No.8-UGC had denotified the BHMTT Course after 05.07.2014. Learned Senior Counsel for Respondent No.4 concedes to the submissions of Counsel for the Petitioners and seeks three weeks' time for issuance of such revised Degrees.

Learned Senior Counsel for the Respondent No.4 shall take steps in consonance with the submissions of Learned Counsel for the Petitioners.
