On 19.08.2016, having noted the deficiencies pointed out in the report submitted by the learned <i>Amicus Curiae</i>, the State Government and other concerned Departments were directed to examine the same and take correct measures. Pursuant thereto, the Direction General-cum-Secretary, Health Care, H.S. & F.W. Deptt., Govt. of Sikkim and Special Secretary, Home Department, Govt. of Sikkim, have filed two affidavits separately, whereunder it was clearly stated that the deficiencies pointed out by the learned <i>Amicus Curiae</i> have been examined and necessary steps have been initiated. Administrative approval and

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		financial sanction has also been obtained in respect of the hospital. The work will commence from 01.11.2016. Learned Additional Advocate General submits that the works will be completed within a period of three months. In respect of deficiencies in Sub-Jail building at Namchi, South Sikkim, it is stated that the Government is preparing estimate and will take necessary steps to improve the defects in the building and make good other requirements.
