Status Report dated 19-06-2018 has been filed by the Respondents No.1, 2 and 3, wherein it is submitted that on scrutiny of records submitted by the Land Revenue and Disaster Management Department (LR&DM) to the Commission, it was revealed that there are number of persons whose names figured in the list that remain untraceable despite efforts made by the concerned District Collectors to locate these persons. The Commission thereafter issued directions upon the LR&DM to inform such persons through Public Notice by publication in the Sikkim Herald and other local newspapers requesting such persons to appear before the concerned District Collectors

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within a period of one month from the date of issuance of Notice. The Office of the District Collectorate would then verify their credentials. It is further stated that the Commission had directed that the list of names of such persons be displayed on the Notice Board of the Office of the District Collectrates, Office of the Sub-Divisional Magistrates and other concerned Offices. Thereafter, the concerned District Collectors will submit the report to the LR&DM Department, which in turn would submit it to the Commission, who will for their part scrutinize and verify the same. For this entire exercise, a period of further 3 (three) months is required.
