O R D E R

IA No. 83286 of 2020 is allowed.

This petition has been filed seeking transfer of H.M. Misc. Petition No. 238 of 2019 titled as "*Vikas Kanwar vs. Manisha Bisht*" pending in the Court of Additional District Judge-II, Una, Himachal Pradesh to the Family Court, Saket, New Delhi.

The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states across the Bar that the petition seeking decree of divorce by mutual consent before the Family Court, Saket, New Delhi in Suit No. 824 of 2021 titled as "*Manisha Bisht vs. Vikas Kanwar*" has been decided on 28.07.2021 and thus, all the disputes between the parties have been settled by the decree of divorce by mutual consent.

The learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the parties have agreed to settle all the disputes between them and have also agreed to withdraw all the proceedings filed by them, which are pending in any other Court in India.

The Respondent has appeared in person and has not disputed the aforesaid factual aspects and is ready to withdraw all the proceedings filed by him in any other Court in India.

In view of the above facts and circumstances, the Transfer Petition has become infructuous and is, accordingly dismissed.

It is, however, directed that the respective parties shall withdraw all the proceedings filed by them, which are pending in any other Court in India.
