There is delay of 1429 days in preferring the instant review petition. The explanation offered in the application seeking condonation of delay is far from being satisfactory. Even then we have considered the matter on merits.

The conviction of the petitioner under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code was affirmed by the High Court which decision was under challenge in this Court. After hearing the counsel for the petitioner, who appeared on behalf of the Supreme Court Legal Services Committee, no substance was found in the matter and the special leave petition was dismissed.

We have gone through the grounds raised in the review petition and do not find any error apparent on record to justify interference in review jurisdiction.

This review petition is, therefore, dismissed on the grounds of delay as well as on merits.
