O R D E R

Though learned counsel for the petitioner has attempted to argue that it had been a case of imposition of major penalty and that could have been done only after following the procedure envisaged by Rule 7 of the Uttar

Pradesh Government Servant (Discipline and Appeal) Rules, 1999 and by holding a regular inquiry but, the learned senior counsel appearing for the respondents has referred to the final penalisation order passed by the Principal Secretary to the Government of Uttar Pradesh, Department of Sugar Industry and has submitted that, as per his instructions, in this case, only the minor penalty of stoppage of one increment with adverse remark in the Character Register was imposed.

Taking note of the submissions so made on behalf of the respondents, we find no reason to examine the contentions sought to be urged on behalf of the petitioner as regards the procedure for imposition of major penalty.

The Special Leave Petition stands disposed of accordingly.

Pending applications also stand disposed of.
