O R D E R

1. As per the Judgment dated 08.11.2019, the respondent- Oil & Natural Gas Corporation Limited (ONGC) was entitled to refund of an amount of Rs. 74,88,768/- (Rupees seventy four lakhs, eighty eight thousand and seven hundred sixty eight). The said amount had not been paid as per the Judgment, the ONGC has, therefore, filed the contempt petition.
2. The petitioner-M/s. Mitra Guha Builders (India) Company, who is the respondent in contempt petition is represented by Mr. Nakul Dewan, learned senior counsel and the respondent-ONGC is represented by Mr. Akshay Amritanshu, learned counsel.
3. The respondent in Contempt Petition - M/s. Mitra Guha Builders (India) Company has paid an amount of Rs. 1,19,10,062 (Rupees One Crore Nineteen Lakhs Ten Thousand and Sixty Two) by way of a cheque.
4. Mr. Nakul Dewan, learned senior counsel appearing for the

respondent in the Contempt Petition has submitted that the respondent has filed a review petition and the same is pending in the Registry. It is further stated that the amount arrived at by the Court i.e. Rs. 74,88,768/- (Rupees seventy four lakhs, eighty eight thousand and seven hundred sixty eight) is not the correct figure and, therefore, he seeks permission to raise additional grounds in the review petition filed before this Court. The liberty as prayed for is granted.

5. Since the substantial amount of Rs. 1,19,10,062 (Rupees One Crore Nineteen Lakhs Ten Thousand and Sixty Two) has been paid to the ONGC. The contempt petition is, accordingly, closed.

6. So far as the full and final satisfaction of the amount is concerned, the same shall be subject to the outcome of the review petition.

7. Misc. applications are, accordingly, disposed of.
