O R D E R

We are informed that the petitioner is under the Corporate Insolvency Resolution Process ('CIRP'). There is no dispute that the petitioner has approached the National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) for reliefs that are the subject matter of these Special Leave Petitions. Mr. Nakul Diwan, learned senior counsel submits that the NCLT by an Order dated 30.1.2020 directed the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent not to utilise the amount of bank guarantee till the next date of hearing. We are further informed that the said order was extended periodically and is in operation. As the NCLT is seized of the matter, we permit the petitioner to withdraw these Special Leave Petitions and approach the NCLT for any further orders.

The Special Leave Petitions are, accordingly, dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty. The applications filed by the petitioner before the NCLT shall be disposed of in accordance with law.
