ORDER

1. We have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned counsel for the State of Uttar Pradesh.

2. Leave granted.

3. The accused appellant is in custody since 13<sup>th</sup> November, 2014. Though the learned counsel for the State submits that charges have been framed the said fact is disputed by the learned counsel for the accused appellant. In any event, the trial has not commenced. Taking into account the long period of custody suffered and the facts stated above we are inclined to release the appellant on bail. Therefore, the appellant is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the learned Sessions Judge, Jaunpur in connection with Case Crime/FIR

No.957 of 2014 dated 12<sup>th</sup> November, 2014 registered at P.S. Sikrara, District Jaunpur, State of U.P.

4. The learned Sessions Judge, Jaunpur is free to impose such condition(s) as may be considered appropriate.

5. Consequently, the order of the High Court is set aside and the present appeal is disposed of in the above terms.
