O R D E R

1. Leave granted.
2. We have perused the factual position depicted in the application seeking permission to intervene. We have also perused the impugned judgment, whereby the application under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been declined on account of the fact, that the appellant before this Court declined to reconcile with the complainant (the applicant seeking permission to intervene).
3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, which may eventually have a bearing on the outcome of the proceedings before the trial court, we are satisfied, that the impugned judgment deserves to be set aside, as we

are of the view that the appellant is entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail. Ordered accordingly. In the event of the appellant's arrest, he shall furnish personal security of Rs.10,000/- to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, with one surety of like amount.

4. The appeal and the Criminal Miscellaneous Petition for seeking permission to intervene are disposed of in the above terms.
