Leave granted.

This appeal arises from an order dated 2 March 2015 of the High Court of Jharkhand in Anticipatory Bail Application No. 2696/2014. The High Court rejected the application.

The appellants are respectively the father in law and the mother in law of the second respondent. The second respondent has instituted a complaint under Section 498A, 406, 423 and 506 of the Penal Code and under the Dowry Prohibition Act.

The Court has been apprised of the fact that anticipatory bail has been granted to the brother-in-law and sister-in-law of the complainant. Subsequently, the husband of the second respondent was released on bail.

On 6 May 2015 while issuing notice, a protective order was passed in the following terms:

"Issue notice.

In the meantime, pre-arrest bail is granted to the petitioners in connection with Complaint Case No. 1201/2013 pending before S.D.J.M., Bokaro, to the satisfaction of the Trial Court."

The office report indicates that service is complete.

In view of the facts and circumstances, we confirm the order dated 6 May 2015.

The appeal is, accordingly, allowed in the above terms.
