UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

Learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that he has no grievance to deposit Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees three lakhs only) to the credit of Crime No.89 of 2019 before the Judicial Magistrate No.II, Sivakasi as a condition for bail. The grievance is that the High Court directed disbursal of the amount to all the persons who are alleged to have been cheated by her. Learned senior counsel

further submits that there is no objection for the disbursal for an amount of Rs.80,000/- (Rupees eighty thousand only) to the complainant. He further submits that the petitioner has settled the dispute with other persons who are alleged to have been cheated.

In view of the above, we permit the petitioner to approach the High Court for modification of the condition pertaining to the disbursal of the amount to those who were not before the Court, within a period of two weeks from today.

The Special Leave Petition is disposed of.
